

ROLE AND PLACE OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE CARD IN EARLY IDENTIFICATION OF ECHINOCOCCA DISEASE

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Echinococcal disease (ED) is an epidemiological pathology in a number of regions of the world, including the Republic of Uzbekistan (Nazarov F. G., co-author 2016). Insufficient awareness of the population about ED, its causes and clinical manifestations, and non-compliance with basic rules of prevention led to the development of a "questionnaire-card" (questionnaire) for the examination of patients suffering from ED.

Purpose of work: develop and implement a "questionnaire card" for early detection and prevention of echinococcal disease in practical healthcare.

Materials and methods of research: the questionnaire card was developed by the staff of the department of General surgery of the ASMI, which was reviewed and approved at the meeting of the problem Commission on surgery and hygiene.

The survey of patients suffering from echinococcal disease is conducted using the questionnaires provided in the questionnaire card.

The questionnaire card includes the following questionnaires:

- information about the patient suffering from ED;
- the circumstances and conditions in which infection is important from the point of view of occurrence of;
 - sanitary and hygienic living conditions for patients suffering from ED;
 - questionnaires to identify nutritional hygiene factors and the main causes that contribute to the development of ED;
 - questionnaires for determining the status of operated patients for ED;

The questionnaire card is intended for:

- persons at risk;
- persons working in the field of agriculture;
- persons who have close contact with animals;
- people living in rural areas;
- operated patients for ED;

Thus, the "questionnaire card" in our opinion will contribute to the early identification of the main causes and clinical signs of the disease, qualitatively assess the condition of operated patients, and make it possible to timely and purposefully draw up a plan for conducting hygienic and surgical measures for ED. The "questionnaire card" will serve as the main criterion for evaluating antiparasitic therapy both in the pre - and postoperative period and it is a very simple and affordable, as well as a scientifically based method for examining ED patients and can be recommended for general use in practical healthcare.
